

Animal Welfare Policy

At Aventuras 2000 we are committed to offering sustainable and continuously improved tourism services that manage our social, cultural, economic and environmental impacts, satisfying our clients and complying with the legal regulations and requirements established by TraveLife.

To ensure compliance, we have established the following animal and wildlife welfare guidelines for the tourist tours that we operate and / or commercialize:

- Operate and / or market tours that include contact with wildlife only if the site or tour has been duly authorized by the corresponding environmental authorities, and also verifying that the authorization or license is in force.
- Periodically evaluate (annually) each of the tours that we operate and / or commercialize, identifying if they include interaction with wildlife, their risks and opportunities for improvement.
- Train our Tourist Guides in Animal Welfare, promoting the use of TraveLife training tools and their corresponding certification.
- In all tours that we operate and market, it is expressly forbidden to touch and / or feed wild animals.
